



BIANNUAL SUMMARY OF PAP TEST RESULTS

VCS provides practitioners with a summary of Pap test results every 6 months. These summary reports include the numbers and proportions of abnormal and unsatisfactory smears, and those with an endocervical component.

An endocervical component on a Pap test tells us that you have been able to sample above the transformation zone (TZ), the area where squamous cell cancer arises. However it is not always possible to obtain these cells.

The report groups the total number of Pap tests you have taken into: those women aged <50; those in this group who are pregnant; and those aged 50+. These groupings are done because with increasing age the TZ tends to retract within the canal; hence we anticipate a lower endocervical component percentage rate in the smears of women aged 50+. As the endocervical brush cannot be used during pregnancy, we also expect a lower percentage in this group.
